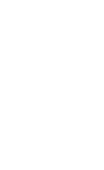

Please consider the following message from the OC:

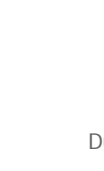
For security reasons you will need to wear a badge (i.e. to register) to be able to enter the conference area, which includes the Opening plenary on Monday morning.

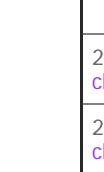

NATCA Announces Position on Air Traffic Control Reform Proposal



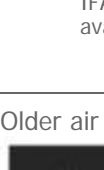

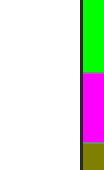
